1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the sale of certain wine by the holder of a wine and beer
 1-20 retailer's permit or mixed beverage permit.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 25.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 25.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. The holder of a wine and
 1-25 beer retailer's permit may sell:

1-26 (1) for consumption on or off the premises where sold,
 1-27 but not for resale, wine, beer, and malt liquors containing alcohol
 1-28 in excess of one-half of one percent by volume and not more than 17
 1-29 percent by volume; and

1-30 (2) for consumption on the premises, the following
 1-31 beverages [~~traditional port or sherry~~] containing alcohol in excess
 1-32 of one-half of one percent by volume and not more than 24 percent by
 1-33 volume;

- 1-34 (A) traditional port or sherry;
- 1-35 (B) dessert-flavored wine; or
- 1-36 (C) rice wine.

1-37 SECTION 2. Section 28.01(c), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-38 amended to read as follows:

1-39 (c) The holder of a mixed beverage permit may also:

1-40 (1) purchase wine, beer, ale, and malt liquor
 1-41 containing alcohol of not more than 24 [~~21~~] percent by volume in
 1-42 containers of any legal size from any permittee or licensee
 1-43 authorized to sell those beverages for resale; and

1-44 (2) sell the wine, beer, ale, and malt liquor for
 1-45 consumption on the licensed premises.

1-46 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
