BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Article 56.42(d), Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

1-22 1-23 (d) A [victim who is a] victim of stalking, family violence, or trafficking of persons, [or] a victim of sexual assault who is 1-24 assaulted in the victim's place of residence, or a child who is a 1-25 1-26 victim of a murder attempt in the child's place of residence may 1-27 1-28 receive a onetime-only assistance payment in an amount not to exceed:

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a victim of a criminal offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. A criminal offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the 1-35 1-36 1-37 1-38 1-39 date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, a criminal 1-40 offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any 1-41 1-42 element of the offense occurred before that date.
