## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to the eligibility of a first responder for workers' 2 3 compensation benefits for post-traumatic stress disorder. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 504.019(b), Labor Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 7 (b) Post-traumatic stress disorder suffered by a first responder is a compensable injury under this subtitle only if it is 8 based on a diagnosis that: 9 (1) the disorder is caused by an event or exposure to 10 11 multiple events occurring in the course and scope of the first 12 responder's employment; and 13 (2) the preponderance of the evidence indicates that 14 the event or exposure to multiple events was a substantial contributing factor of the disorder. 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 16 a claim for workers' compensation benefits based on a 17 to compensable injury that occurs on or after the effective date of 18 this Act. A claim based on a compensable injury that occurs before 19 that date is governed by the law as it existed on the date the 20 21 compensable injury occurred, and the former law is continued in 22 effect for that purpose. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 23
