A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-17 1-18 relating to the use of a perpetual trust fund for a cemetery by certain municipalities. 1-19

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 713.008, Health and Safety Code, is 1-21 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 713.008. TERMINATION OF MUNICIPAL TRUST BY CERTAIN PALITIES. (a) The governing body of a municipality in a 1-22 1-23 MUNICIPALITIES. (a) county with a population of at least 128,000 but not more than 1-24 1-25 300,000 may abolish the municipality's perpetual trust fund for a cemetery and use the fund, including both principal and interest, for permanent improvements to the cemetery. 1-26 1-27 1-28

(b) The governing body of a municipality in a county with a population of at least 40,000 but not more than 80,000 and that 1-29 contains a portion of the Angelina National Forest may abolish the municipality's perpetual trust fund for a cemetery and use the fund, including both principal and interest, for permanent improvements to the cemetery. Termination of a trust fund under 1-30 1-31 1-32 1-33 this subsection does not constitute renouncement of a trust or 1-34 failure to act as its trustee under this subchapter. 1-35 1-36

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
