1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the use of municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue in
1-24 certain municipalities.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 351.1066(a), Tax Code, is amended to
1-27 read as follows:

1-28 (a) This section applies only to:

1-29 (1) a municipality with a population of at least 3,500
1-30 but less than 5,500 that is the county seat of a county with a
1-31 population of less than 50,000 that borders a county with a
1-32 population of more than 1.6 million;

1-33 (2) a municipality with a population of at least 2,900
1-34 but less than 3,500 that is the county seat of a county with a
1-35 population of less than 22,000 that is bordered by the Trinity River
1-36 and includes a state park and a portion of a wildlife management
1-37 area;

1-38 (3) a municipality with a population of at least 7,500
1-39 that is located in a county that borders the Pecos River and that
1-40 has a population of not more than 15,000;

1-41 (4) a municipality with a population of not more than
1-42 5,000 that is located in a county through which the Frio River flows
1-43 and an interstate highway crosses, and that has a population of at
1-44 least 15,000; ~~and~~

1-45 (5) a municipality with a population of not less than
1-46 7,500 that is located in a county with a population of not less than
1-47 40,000 but less than 250,000 that is adjacent to a county with a
1-48 population of less than 750;

1-49 (6) a municipality that is the county seat of a county
1-50 with a population of at least 8,500 and that county contains part of
1-51 the Chaparral Wildlife Management Area; and

1-52 (7) a municipality that has a population of not more
1-53 than 25,000, that contains a cultural heritage museum, and that is
1-54 located in a county that borders the United Mexican States and the
1-55 Gulf of Mexico.

1-56 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
