1-18 relating to the amount credited in a state fiscal year to the
 1-19 judicial fund to provide basic civil legal services.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 402.007(d), Government Code, is amended
 1-22 to read as follows:

1-23 (d) The total amount credited to the judicial fund for
 1-24 programs approved by the supreme court that provide basic civil
 1-25 legal services to the indigent under Subsection (b) may not exceed
 1-26 \$50 million per state fiscal year [~~biennium~~].

1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-29 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
