1-16 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to evidence of ownership of temporary housing provided by
 1-19 a government agency in response to a natural disaster or other
 1-20 declared emergency.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 1201, Occupations Code, is
 1-23 amended by adding Section 1201.2071 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 1201.2071. EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN EMERGENCY HOUSING.

1-25 (a) Sections 1201.204, 1201.205, 1201.206, and 1201.207 do not
 1-26 apply to the purchase of a manufactured home that is purchased by a
 1-27 federal governmental agency and used to provide temporary housing
 1-28 in response to a natural disaster or other declared emergency.

1-29 (b) The department shall adopt rules for the application for
 1-30 and automatic issuance of a statement of ownership of a
 1-31 manufactured home described by Subsection (a).

1-32 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 501, Transportation Code,
 1-33 is amended by adding Section 501.0341 to read as follows:

1-34 Sec. 501.0341. ISSUANCE OF TITLE TO GOVERNMENT AGENCY FOR

1-35 TRAVEL TRAILER. (a) The department by rule shall establish a
 1-36 process to automatically issue a title to a government agency for a
 1-37 travel trailer used by the government agency to provide temporary
 1-38 housing in response to a natural disaster or other declared
 1-39 emergency.

1-40 (b) Notwithstanding Section 501.004(b)(3), rules adopted
 1-41 under this section may provide for the issuance of a title for a
 1-42 travel trailer described by Subsection (a) that is owned or
 1-43 operated by the United States or transferred to a state agency from
 1-44 the United States.

1-45 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
