1-24 relating to the eligibility of certain events to receive funding
 1-25 through the Major Events Reimbursement Program.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Sections 5A(a)(4) and (5), Chapter 1507 (S.B.
 1-28 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article
 1-29 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are amended to read as
 1-30 follows:

1-31 (4) "Event" means a Super Bowl, a National Collegiate
 1-32 Athletic Association Final Four tournament game, the National
 1-33 Basketball Association All-Star Game, the X Games, the National
 1-34 Hockey League All-Star Game, the Major League Baseball All-Star
 1-35 Game, a game of the National Collegiate Athletic Association Bowl
 1-36 Championship Series or its successor or a National Collegiate
 1-37 Athletic Association Division I Football Bowl Subdivision
 1-38 postseason playoff or championship game, a Big 12 Football
 1-39 Conference Championship game, the National Collegiate Athletic
 1-40 Association men's or women's lacrosse championships, a World Cup
 1-41 Soccer game, the World Cup soccer tournament, the Major League
 1-42 Soccer All-Star Game, the Major League Soccer Cup, the Professional
 1-43 Rodeo Cowboys Association National Finals Rodeo, an Elite Rodeo
 1-44 Association World Championship, the United States Open
 1-45 Championship, the World Games, a national collegiate championship
 1-46 of an amateur sport sanctioned by the national governing body of the
 1-47 sport that is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, an
 1-48 Olympic activity, including a Junior or Senior activity, training
 1-49 program, or feeder program sanctioned by the United States Olympic
 1-50 Committee's Community Olympic Development Program, the Amateur
 1-51 Athletic Union Junior Olympic Games, a mixed martial arts
 1-52 championship, a World Wrestling Entertainment WrestleMania event,
 1-53 the Breeders' Cup World Championships, a Formula One automobile
 1-54 race, the Moto Grand Prix of the United States, the National
 1-55 Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR) All-Star Race, the
 1-56 season-ending Championship Race for the National Association for
 1-57 Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR), the Academy of Country Music
 1-58 Awards, the National Cutting Horse Association Triple Crown, a
 1-59 championship event in the National Reined Cow Horse Association
 1-60 (NRCHA) Championship Series, a national political convention of the

2-1 Republican National Committee or the Democratic National
2-2 Committee, a presidential general election debate, or the largest
2-3 event held each year at a sports entertainment venue in this state
2-4 with a permanent seating capacity, including grandstand and premium
2-5 seating, of not less than 125,000. The term includes any activities
2-6 related to or associated with an event.

2-7 (5) "Site selection organization" means:
2-8 (A) the National Football League, the National
2-9 Collegiate Athletic Association, the Big 12 Conference, the
2-10 National Basketball Association, ESPN or an affiliate, the National
2-11 Hockey League, Major League Baseball, the Federation
2-12 Internationale de Football Association (FIFA), the International
2-13 World Games Association, the National Association for Stock Car
2-14 Auto Racing (NASCAR), Dorna Sports, the Amateur Athletic Union, the
2-15 Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association, the Elite Rodeo
2-16 Association, Major League Soccer, the United States Golf
2-17 Association, or the United States Olympic Committee;

2-18 (B) the national governing body of a sport that
2-19 is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, the National
2-20 Thoroughbred Racing Association, Formula One Management Limited,
2-21 or the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile;

2-22 (C) the Academy of Country Music;

2-23 (D) the National Cutting Horse Association;

2-24 (E) the National Reined Cow Horse Association
2-25 (NRCHA);

2-26 (F) the Republican National Committee or the
2-27 Democratic National Committee;

2-28 (G) [~~(F)~~] the Ultimate Fighting Championship;
2-29 [~~(F)~~]

2-30 (H) World Wrestling Entertainment; or

2-31 (I) [~~(G)~~] the Commission on Presidential
2-32 Debates.

2-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
