1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to a mandatory term of confinement for defendants placed  
 1-18 on community supervision for the criminal offense of leaving the  
 1-19 scene of a motor vehicle accident resulting in the death of a  
 1-20 person.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 42A, Code of Criminal  
 1-23 Procedure, is amended by adding Article 42A.515 to read as follows:

1-24 Art. 42A.515. COMMUNITY SUPERVISION FOR LEAVING SCENE OF  
 1-25 MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT RESULTING IN DEATH OF PERSON. (a) A judge  
 1-26 granting community supervision to a defendant convicted of an  
 1-27 offense punishable under Section 550.021(c)(1)(A), Transportation  
 1-28 Code, shall require as a condition of community supervision that  
 1-29 the defendant submit to a term of confinement of not less than 120  
 1-30 days.

1-31 (b) If a sentence of confinement is imposed on the  
 1-32 revocation of community supervision, the term of confinement served  
 1-33 under Subsection (a) may not be credited toward completion of the  
 1-34 sentence imposed.

1-35 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
 1-36 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.  
 1-37 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is  
 1-38 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,  
 1-39 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For  
 1-40 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the  
 1-41 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred  
 1-42 before that date.

1-43 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
