 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the development by the Texas Veterans Commission of an
 1-18 online repository of information of use to active duty military
 1-19 relocating to this state.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
 1-22 amended by adding Section 434.026 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 434.026. ONLINE REPOSITORY FOR ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY.

1-24 (a) The Texas Veterans Commission shall develop and maintain on the
 1-25 state electronic Internet portal project described by Section
 1-26 2054.252 an online repository of information of use to active duty
 1-27 members of the United States armed forces and their families
 1-28 relocating to this state.

1-29 (b) The repository under Subsection (a) must include
 1-30 information on assistance, fee waivers, and programs the state
 1-31 provides to active duty members of the United States armed forces
 1-32 and their families related to occupational and professional
 1-33 licenses, education, and health care.

1-34 (c) A link to the repository developed under Subsection (a)
 1-35 must be prominently displayed on the public home page of the state
 1-36 electronic Internet portal project described by Section 2054.252.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
