 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 84 in  
 1-21 McLennan County as the Waco Police Sgt. Bobby Vicha Memorial  
 1-22 Highway.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
 1-25 is amended by adding Section 225.152 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 225.152. WACO POLICE SGT. BOBBY VICHA MEMORIAL  
 1-27 HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of U.S. Highway 84 in McLennan County  
 1-28 between its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1330 and its  
 1-29 intersection with North Vicha Road is designated as the Waco Police  
 1-30 Sgt. Bobby Vicha Memorial Highway.

1-31 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-32 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
 1-33 designation as the Waco Police Sgt. Bobby Vicha Memorial Highway  
 1-34 and any other appropriate information; and

1-35 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
 1-36 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
