1-17 relating to municipal boundaries used to determine a cemetery  
1-18 location.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 711.008(e), Health and Safety Code, is  
1-21 amended to read as follows:

1-22 (e) For the purpose of determining where a cemetery may be  
1-23 located under Subsection (a), the boundary of an area annexed by a  
1-24 municipality is not considered to be a boundary of the municipality  
1-25 if:

1-26 (1) no more than 10 percent of the boundary of the  
1-27 annexed area is composed of a part of the boundary of the annexing  
1-28 municipality as it existed immediately before the annexation; or

1-29 (2) the annexed area cannot be developed as  
1-30 residential or commercial property and is primarily used for flood  
1-31 control.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
