1-22 relating to the repeal of the provisions providing for the
 1-23 suspension of the collection of certain fees when the balance in the
 1-24 oil and gas regulation and cleanup fund exceeds a specified amount.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 81.116(d), Natural Resources Code, is
 1-27 amended to read as follows:

1-28 (d) ~~[The comptroller shall suspend collection of the fee in~~
 1-29 ~~the manner provided by Section 81.067.]~~ The exemptions and
 1-30 reductions set out in Sections 202.052, 202.054, 202.056, 202.057,
 1-31 202.059, and 202.060, Tax Code, do not affect the fee imposed by
 1-32 this section.

1-33 SECTION 2. Section 81.117(d), Natural Resources Code, is
 1-34 amended to read as follows:

1-35 (d) ~~[The comptroller shall suspend collection of the fee in~~
 1-36 ~~the manner provided by Section 81.067.]~~ The exemptions and
 1-37 reductions set out in Sections 201.053, 201.057, 201.058, and
 1-38 202.060, Tax Code, do not affect the fee imposed by this section.

1-39 SECTION 3. Section 81.067(b), Natural Resources Code, is
 1-40 repealed.

1-41 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
