BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Sections 402.104(a) and (d), Occupations Code, are amended to read as follows:

(a) The department shall 1-24 develop and maintain an examination that may include a written [, oral,] or practical test 1-25 1-26 [tests]. The department shall administer or arrange for the 1-27 1-28

administration <u>and validation</u> of the examination. (d) The practical <u>test</u> [examination] must be administered by one or more qualified proctors selected and assigned by the 1-29 1-30 department.
