1-16 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to the authority of a governmental unit that has withdrawn
1-19 from a regional planning commission to join another regional
1-20 planning commission.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Chapter 391, Local Government Code, is amended
1-23 by adding Section 391.016 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 391.016. JOINING COMMISSION AFTER WITHDRAWAL. A
1-25 governmental unit that has withdrawn from a commission under
1-26 Section 391.015 may join another commission that is adjacent to the
1-27 unit if:

1-28 (1) the transfer is approved by the governing bodies
1-29 of:

1-30 (A) the unit; and

1-31 (B) the commission the unit wishes to join;

1-32 (2) the governmental unit submits a written request
1-33 for approval of the transfer to the governor that:

1-34 (A) is in the form and manner prescribed by the
1-35 office of the governor; and

1-36 (B) demonstrates the transfer furthers the
1-37 purpose of this chapter as described by Section 391.001; and

1-38 (3) the governor approves the transfer.

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-40 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-41 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-42 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-43 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
