 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to certain notice requirements applicable to massage
 1-23 therapy.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 455, Occupations Code, is
 1-26 amended by adding Section 455.207 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 455.207. POSTING OF CERTAIN NOTICES REQUIRED. (a)
 1-28 Each massage establishment and massage school shall display in the
 1-29 form and manner prescribed by the commission a sign concerning
 1-30 services and assistance available to victims of human trafficking.

1-31 (b) The sign required by this section must:

1-32 (1) be in English, Spanish, Korean, Mandarin, and any
 1-33 other language required by commission rule;

1-34 (2) include a toll-free telephone number of a
 1-35 nationally recognized information and referral hotline for victims
 1-36 of human trafficking; and

1-37 (3) be displayed in a conspicuous place clearly
 1-38 visible to the public.

1-39 (c) The commission by rule shall establish requirements
 1-40 regarding the posting of signs under this section.

1-41 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than March 1, 2020, the Texas
 1-42 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules necessary
 1-43 to implement Section 455.207, Occupations Code, as added by this
 1-44 Act.

1-45 (b) A massage establishment, as defined by Section 455.001,
 1-46 Occupations Code, shall comply with Section 455.207, Occupations
 1-47 Code, as added by this Act, not later than April 1, 2020.

1-48 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
