 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the use by certain municipalities of a perpetual trust  
 1-20 fund for a cemetery.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 713.008, Health and Safety Code, is  
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 713.008. TERMINATION OF MUNICIPAL TRUST BY CERTAIN  
 1-25 MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This section applies to the [The] governing  
 1-26 body of a municipality in a county with a population of:

1-27 (1) at least 128,000 but not more than 300,000; or

1-28 (2) at least 20,000 but not more than 21,000.

1-29 (b) The governing body of a municipality to which this  
 1-30 section applies may abolish the municipality's perpetual trust fund  
 1-31 for a cemetery and use the fund, including both principal and  
 1-32 interest, for permanent improvements to the cemetery.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
