 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to requiring the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
 1-21 to provide to a school district certain information used in
 1-22 determining academic accountability ratings for the district.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
 1-25 amended by adding Section 39.059 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 39.059. DATA TRANSPARENCY. (a) In this section:

1-27 (1) "Coordinating board" means the Texas Higher
 1-28 Education Coordinating Board.

1-29 (2) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
 1-30 assigned by Section 61.003.

1-31 (b) Before the initial release of academic accountability
 1-32 ratings for a school year, the coordinating board shall provide to
 1-33 each school district a copy of all source data as submitted to the
 1-34 coordinating board by an institution of higher education that the
 1-35 coordinating board provides to the agency to consider in:

1-36 (1) determining the district's accreditation status
 1-37 under Section 39.052; or

1-38 (2) assigning performance ratings for the district or
 1-39 the district's campuses under Section 39.054.

1-40 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
 1-41 school year.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
