1-22 relating to the provision of solid waste disposal services in the
 1-23 extraterritorial jurisdiction of certain municipalities.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 364, Health and Safety
 1-26 Code, is amended by adding Section 364.0341 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 364.0341. SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SERVICES IN
 1-28 EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This
 1-29 section applies only to a municipality wholly or partly located in a
 1-30 county with a population of more than 54,000 and less than 54,500.

1-31 (b) Notwithstanding Sections 364.011(a) and 364.034(a), a
 1-32 county may offer, require the use of, and charge a fee for solid
 1-33 waste disposal services in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a
 1-34 municipality.

1-35 (c) A municipality may not provide solid waste disposal
 1-36 services or charge a fee for those services in the municipality's
 1-37 extraterritorial jurisdiction if the county provides those
 1-38 services under Subsection (b).

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
