 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to designating July 20 as Space Exploration Day.
 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-19 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
 1-20 amended by adding Section 662.071 to read as follows:
 1-21 Sec. 662.071. SPACE EXPLORATION DAY. (a) July 20 is Space
 1-22 Exploration Day in honor of the heroes of Apollo 11 and those who
 1-23 continue to pursue innovation and exploration.
 1-24 (b) Space Exploration Day may be regularly observed by
 1-25 appropriate ceremonies and activities.
 1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
