 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to developing the proposed plan on long-term care for
 1-20 persons with an intellectual disability.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 533A.062, Health and Safety Code, is
 1-23 amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

1-24 (b-1) As part of the proposed plan, the commission shall
 1-25 review the statewide bed capacity of community ICF-IID facilities
 1-26 for individuals with an intellectual disability or a related
 1-27 condition and, based on the review, develop a process to reallocate
 1-28 beds held in suspension by the commission. The process may include:

1-29 (1) criteria by which ICF-IID program providers may
 1-30 apply to the commission to receive reallocated beds; and

1-31 (2) a means to reallocate the beds among health
 1-32 services regions.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
