1-17 relating to Texas Commission on Environmental Quality reminders to
1-18 public drinking water supply systems regarding reporting
1-19 requirements.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section [341.0315](#), Health and Safety Code, is
1-22 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-23 (e) The commission shall establish a system to provide
1-24 automatic reminders to public drinking water supply systems about
1-25 regular reporting requirements applicable to the systems under the
1-26 federal Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. Section 300f et seq.) and
1-27 this chapter that relate to commission rules adopted under those
1-28 laws. An automatic reminder provided under this subsection is a
1-29 courtesy. A public drinking water supply system is responsible for
1-30 complying with applicable regular reporting requirements
1-31 regardless of whether the commission provides automatic reminders.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
