1-22 relating to the terms of dissolution of an oil or gas pooled unit.  
 1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-24 SECTION 1. Section [102.082](#), Natural Resources Code, is  
 1-25 amended to read as follows:  
 1-26 Sec. 102.082. AUTOMATIC DISSOLUTION. A unit is  
 1-27 automatically dissolved:  
 1-28 (1) two years [~~one year~~] after its effective date if no  
 1-29 production or drilling operations have been had on the unit or  
 1-30 surface location for the unit;  
 1-31 (2) six months after the completion of a dry hole on  
 1-32 the unit; or  
 1-33 (3) six months after cessation of production from the  
 1-34 unit.  
 1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
