1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the posting of certain notices in a primary election.  
1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-21 SECTION 1. Sections 172.1111(a) and (c), Election Code, are  
1-22 amended to read as follows:  
1-23 (a) Before the opening of the polls during the early voting  
1-24 period and on election day, the presiding judge shall post at each  
1-25 outside door through which a voter may enter the building in which  
1-26 the polling place is located a written notice in bold print of the  
1-27 date, hour, and place for each precinct, county, senatorial, or  
1-28 state convention that a voter in the precinct may be eligible to  
1-29 attend during the election year.  
1-30 (c) The notice must remain posted continuously through the  
1-31 early voting period and on election day.  
1-32 SECTION 2. Section 172.1112(a), Election Code, is amended  
1-33 to read as follows:  
1-34 (a) The county clerk shall post a notice of the election and  
1-35 a notice of consolidated precincts, if applicable, in the manner  
1-36 prescribed by Section 4.003(b) for general and special elections.  
1-37 The notice of the election shall be posted on the county clerk's  
1-38 [party's] Internet website, if the county clerk [party] maintains a  
1-39 website. If the county clerk [party] does not maintain a website,  
1-40 the notice shall be posted on the bulletin board used for posting  
1-41 notice of meetings of the commissioners court.  
1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
