1-18 relating to the electronic submission of forms, data, and documents  
 1-19 to the Commission on Jail Standards; imposing a fee.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Chapter 511, Government Code, is amended by  
 1-22 adding Section 511.0104 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 511.0104. ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION OF FORMS, DATA, AND  
 1-24 DOCUMENTS. (a) The commission shall establish a system for the  
 1-25 electronic submission of forms, data, and documents required to be  
 1-26 submitted to the commission under this chapter or a rule adopted  
 1-27 under this chapter.

1-28 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a person shall  
 1-29 submit all forms, data, or documents described by Subsection (a) to  
 1-30 the commission through the system established under that subsection  
 1-31 and in a standardized electronic format prescribed by the  
 1-32 commission.

1-33 (c) The commission may allow a person to submit the forms,  
 1-34 data, or documents described by Subsection (a) in a nonelectronic  
 1-35 format. The commission shall set and collect a reasonable fee to  
 1-36 cover the cost of processing the forms, data, or documents.

1-37 (d) The commission may adopt rules as necessary to implement  
 1-38 this section.

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
