1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the route designation for the issuance of a permit for
 1-23 the movement of oversize and overweight vehicles in certain
 1-24 counties.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 623.219, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-27 by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

1-28 (b-1) For a permit issued by a port authority contiguous to
 1-29 the Gulf of Mexico or a bay or inlet opening into the gulf with a
 1-30 population of not more than 200,000 that is adjacent to a county
 1-31 described in Subsection (b), the commission shall, with the consent
 1-32 of the port authority, designate the most direct route from:

1-33 (1) the Matagorda County line to the entrance of the
 1-34 Port of Palacios using State Highway 35;

1-35 (2) the Matagorda County line to the entrance of the
 1-36 Port of Palacios using State Highway 60;

1-37 (3) the Matagorda County line to the entrance of the
 1-38 Port of Palacios using FM 521; and

1-39 (4) the Matagorda County line to the entrance of the
 1-40 Port of Palacios using State Highway 71.

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-42 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-44 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-45 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
