## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the dissolution of fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services districts. 1-17 1-18 1-19

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 344.260(a), Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-21

1-22 1-23 (a) If less than a majority of the votes cast in a continuation referendum election are for the continuation of a district or if a majority of the votes cast in a dissolution 1-24 1-25 referendum are for dissolution of the district:

1-26 (1) the board shall certify that fact to the secretary 1-27 1-28 of state not later than the 10th day after the date of the canvass of the returns; and

1-29 (2) the district is dissolved and ceases to operate as 1-30 provided by Section 344.301.

1-31 SECTION 2. Section 344.301, Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-32

1-33 Sec. 344.301. TIME FOR DISSOLUTION OF DISTRICT. (a) Α 1-34 district is dissolved on the first uniform election date that occurs after the fifth anniversary of [five years after] the date the municipality began to impose taxes for district purposes if the district has not held a continuation or dissolution referendum. 1-35 1-36 1-37

1-38 (b) The district is dissolved on the first uniform election date that occurs after the fifth anniversary of the date of the most 1-39 recent continuation or dissolution referendum. 1-40

1-41 (c) Subsection (b) does not apply to a district that is 1-42 continued under Section 344.251(g), and that district is dissolved 1-43 on the first uniform election date that occurs after the end [expiration] of the period for which it was continued. 1 - 441-45

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
