1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to an intercollegiate athletics fee at the University of
1-22 North Texas at Dallas.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
1-25 amended by adding Section 54.5192 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 54.5192. INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS FEE; UNIVERSITY OF
1-27 NORTH TEXAS AT DALLAS. (a) The board of regents of the University
1-28 of North Texas System may charge each student enrolled at the
1-29 University of North Texas at Dallas an intercollegiate athletics
1-30 fee in an initial amount not to exceed \$10 per semester credit hour
1-31 for each regular semester or summer session. The amount of the fee
1-32 may be increased only as provided by Subsection (e).

1-33 (b) A student enrolled in more than 12 semester credit hours
1-34 shall pay the fee in an amount equal to the amount charged a student
1-35 enrolled in 12 semester credit hours during the same semester or
1-36 session.

1-37 (c) Revenue from the fee charged under this section may be
1-38 used only to develop and maintain an intercollegiate athletics
1-39 program at the university.

1-40 (d) The fee may not be charged unless approved by a majority
1-41 vote of the students enrolled at the university who participate in a
1-42 general student election held for that purpose.

1-43 (e) The amount of the fee per semester credit hour may be
1-44 increased from one academic year to the next only if approved by a
1-45 majority vote of the students participating in a general student
1-46 election held for that purpose or, if the amount of the increase
1-47 does not exceed five percent, by a majority vote of the legislative
1-48 body of the student government of the university.

1-49 (f) The ballot proposition for an election to approve a
1-50 proposed initial fee under Subsection (d) or a proposed fee
1-51 increase under Subsection (e) must:

1-52 (1) clearly state the amount of the proposed fee or fee
1-53 increase, as applicable; and

1-54 (2) describe the reason for the proposed fee or fee
1-55 increase, as applicable.

1-56 (g) A fee charged under this section is in addition to any
1-57 other fee authorized by law and may not be considered in determining
1-58 the maximum amount of student services fees that may be charged each
1-59 student enrolled at the university under Section 54.503.

1-60 SECTION 2. A fee may not be charged under Section 54.5192,

2-1 Education Code, as added by this Act, before the 2019 fall semester.
2-2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
