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- 14 (b) Members of the board appointed under Subsection (a) (6) 15 serve staggered two-year terms, with the terms of the members 16 described by Subsections  $\underline{(a)(6)(A)-(F)}$   $\underline{(a)(6)(A)-(E)}$  expiring on 17 February 1 of each odd-numbered year and the terms of the members 18 described by Subsections  $\underline{(a)(6)(G)-(J)}$   $\underline{(a)(6)(F)-(I)}$  expiring on 19 February 1 of each even-numbered year. A member may serve more than 20 one term.
- 21 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than February 1, 2020, governor shall appoint new members to the board of directors of the 22 Texas School Safety Center as required by Section 37.203(a)(6)(I), 23 24 Education Code, as amended by this Act, 37.203(a)(6)(J), Education Code, as added by this Act. 25
- 26 (b) Section 37.203, Education Code, as amended by this Act, 27 does not affect the term of the member appointed under Section

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- 1 37.203(a)(6)(F), Education Code, as amended by this Act, and
- 2 serving on the board immediately before the effective date of this
- 3 Act. After the term of that member expires on February 1, 2020, the
- 4 governor shall appoint a member who meets the requirements under
- 5 Section 37.203(a)(6)(F), Education Code, as amended by this Act, to
- 6 a term expiring February 1, 2021.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
