(a) A charitable organization, or an employee 8 or volunteer thereof, acting in good faith is immune from civil 9 liability for any act to disclose information reasonably believed 10 to be true about allegations that any person, while employed by or 11 serving as a volunteer of the charitable organization engaged in 12 sexual misconduct, sexually abused another person, sexually 13 14 harassed another person, or otherwise committed an offense under Chapter 21, Penal Code, or under Chapter 43, Penal Code to the 15 16 current employer or a prospective employer of that person. (b) A person who reports the person's own sexual abuse, 17 sexual harassment, or offense under Chapter 21, Penal Code, or 18 under Chapter 43, Penal Code, or who acts in bad faith or with 19 malicious purpose in making a disclosure under subsection (a) is 20 not immune from civil or criminal liability. 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
