- 10 undergraduate to doctoral degrees, at Texas Southern University
- 11 with a goal to establish a program before the start of the 87th
- 12 regular legislative session; and, be it further

- 14 copy of this resolution to the chair of the Texas Higher Education
- 15 Coordinating Board.
