1-17 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-18 proposing a constitutional amendment permitting a person to hold  
 1-19 more than one office as a municipal judge at the same time.

1-20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 40, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is  
 1-22 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-23 (e) Notwithstanding Subsections (a) and (c) of this  
 1-24 section, a person may hold more than one office as an elected or  
 1-25 appointed municipal judge in more than one municipality at the same  
 1-26 time.

1-27 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
 1-28 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.  
 1-29 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
 1-30 proposition: "The constitutional amendment permitting a person to  
 1-31 hold more than one office as a municipal judge at the same time."
