1-23 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-24 proposing a constitutional amendment allowing increased
 1-25 distributions to the available school fund.

1-26 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Section 5(g), Article VII, Texas Constitution,
 1-28 is amended to read as follows:

1-29 (g) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
 1-30 constitution or of a statute, the State Board of Education, the
 1-31 General Land Office, or another [an] entity [other than the State
 1-32 Board of Education] that has responsibility for the management of
 1-33 revenues derived from permanent school fund land or other
 1-34 properties may, in its sole discretion and in addition to other
 1-35 distributions authorized under this constitution or a statute,
 1-36 distribute to the available school fund each year revenue derived
 1-37 during that year from the land or properties, not to exceed \$600
 1-38 [~~\$300~~] million by each entity each year.

1-39 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
 1-40 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
 1-41 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
 1-42 proposition: "The constitutional amendment allowing increased
 1-43 distributions to the available school fund."

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
