R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Civic and business leaders from Tyler, Kilgore,
2 Lindale, Gladewater, and Longview are joining together on February
3 26, 2019, to celebrate East Texas Coalition Day at the State
4 Capitol; and

5 WHEREAS, Situated in the Piney Woods region of East Texas,
6 Tyler, Kilgore, Lindale, Gladewater, and Longview share the
7 attributes of great natural beauty, abundant resources, and
8 energetic and engaged citizens, all of which have played a vital
9 role in the growth and prosperity of our state; and

10 WHEREAS, Tyler has a preeminent medical center, as well as
11 multiple institutions of higher education, and it also is home to
12 the renowned Texas Rose Festival and the Municipal Rose Garden and
13 Museum; and

14 WHEREAS, Kilgore is an important center for the oil and high
15 technology industries, and Kilgore College offers such outstanding
16 cultural attractions as the Texas Shakespeare Festival and the
17 world-famous Rangerette drill team Showcase and Museum; and

18 WHEREAS, Lindale has long been known for its impressive
19 blackberry harvest and is home to one of Texas's premier school
20 districts; Lindale ISD has achieved state and national recognition
21 for its tradition of excellence, and Lindale High School has won the
22 5A Academic State Championship meet for the past two years; and

23 WHEREAS, Regarded as the "Antique Capital of East Texas,"
24 Gladewater is nestled at the junction of Gregg, Upshur, and Smith

1 Counties, and it hosts a number of noteworthy events throughout the
2 year, including East Texas Gusher Days, the Roundup Rodeo, and the
3 Arts and Crafts Festival; and

4 WHEREAS, Longview is the largest city in Gregg County and is
5 the location of LeTourneau University; the city boasts the Longview
6 Museum of Fine Arts, one of its several outstanding museums, and the
7 Great Texas Balloon Race; in the past year, the East Texas Advanced
8 Manufacturing Academy opened, and the Longview Lobos reached the
9 pinnacle of high school football success when the team won the 2018
10 UIL 6A Division II state championship; and

11 WHEREAS, The residents of these five notable cities may take
12 great pride in their impressive achievements as they confidently
13 embrace the opportunities of the future, and this special day
14 provides a fitting opportunity to honor them and their unique
15 region of the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
