R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Family and friends will long cherish their memories  
2 of Luther B. Rogers of Llano, who passed away on December 14, 2018,  
3 at the age of 85; and

4           WHEREAS, Born on January 31, 1933, in Houston, Luke Rogers  
5 served his country in the armed forces as both an active duty  
6 soldier and a member of the reserve; during his three decades in the  
7 military, he completed combat tours in Korea and Vietnam and  
8 received assignments to various locations in the United States and  
9 Europe; he later participated in a number of veterans organizations  
10 and reunions; and

11           WHEREAS, Mr. Rogers was also involved in the scouting  
12 movement throughout his life, holding numerous volunteer positions  
13 before eventually becoming a professional scouter; he attained the  
14 rank of Eagle Scout, and he was awarded a 75-year service pin; this  
15 esteemed Texan further contributed to his community as a bailiff  
16 for the Llano court system; and

17           WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Rogers enjoyed the love  
18 and support of his wife, Teddy, with whom he shared a rewarding  
19 marriage that spanned 61 years; he was the proud father of two sons,  
20 Flem and William, and with the passing years, he had the pleasure of  
21 welcoming into his family two grandchildren, Luther and Anna; and

22           WHEREAS, Deeply devoted to the betterment of the world around  
23 him and to the well-being of his fellow citizens, Luke Rogers led a  
24 rich and purposeful life, and he will forever be remembered with

1 deep affection by all who knew him; now, therefore, be it
