2 highway patrol trooper with her graduation from the 164th recruit
3 school of the Texas Department of Public Safety on November 30,
4 2018; and

6 Ms. Justiss began her training in June 2018; during her 26 weeks at
7 the academy, she received instruction in more than 100 subjects,
