4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 322, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 322.0175 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 322.0175. STRATEGIC FISCAL REVIEW OF STATE AGENCIES
8	AND PROGRAMS. (a) The board shall perform a strategic fiscal
9	review for each state agency currently the subject of Sunset
10	Advisory Commission review under Chapter 325.
11	(b) The board shall prepare and submit a report of the
12	findings of the strategic fiscal review by September 1 of the
13	even-numbered year of the biennium during which the review is
14	conducted to the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the
15	house of representatives and to the members of the senate finance
16	and house appropriations committees.
17	(c) The strategic fiscal review report must contain:
18	(1) a description of the discrete activities the state
19	agency is charged with conducting or performing together with:
20	(A) a justification for each activity by
21	reference to a statute or other legal authority; and
22	(B) an evaluation of the effectiveness and

efficiency of the state agency's policies, management, fiscal

affairs, and operations in relation to each activity;

1	(2) for each activity identified under Subdivision
2	<u>(1):</u>
3	(A) a quantitative estimate of any adverse
4	effects that reasonably may be expected to result if the activity
5	were discontinued, together with a description of the methods by
6	which the adverse effects were estimated;
7	(B) an itemized account of expenditures required
8	to maintain the activity at the minimum level of service or
9	performance required by the statute or other legal authority,
10	together with a concise statement of the quantity and quality of
11	service or performance required at that minimum level; and
12	(C) an itemized account of expenditures required
13	to maintain the activity at the current level of service or
14	performance, together with a concise statement of the quantity and
15	quality of service or performance provided at that current level;
16	(3) a ranking of activities identified under
17	Subdivision (1) that illustrates the relative importance of each
18	activity to the overall goals and purposes of the state agency at
19	current service or performance levels; and
20	(4) recommendations to the legislature regarding
21	whether the legislature should continue funding each activity
22	identified under Subdivision (1) and, if so, at what level.
23	(d) The legislature may consider the strategic fiscal
24	review reports in connection with the legislative appropriations
25	process.
26	(e) Until the board has completed a strategic fiscal review
27	under this section, all information, documentary or otherwise,

- prepared or maintained in conducting the strategic fiscal review or
 preparing the strategic fiscal review report, including
 intra-agency and interagency communications and drafts of the
 strategic fiscal review report, or portions of those drafts, is
 excepted from required public disclosure as audit working papers
 under Section 552.116. This subsection does not affect whether
 information described by this subsection is confidential or
 excepted from required public disclosure under a law other than
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
