BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 34.01(2), Penal Code, is amended to read 1-20 as follows:

"Funds" includes:

1-21 (A) coin or paper money of the United States or any other country that is designated as legal tender and that circulates and is customarily used and accepted as a medium of 1-22 1-23 1-24 1-25 exchange in the country of issue;

(B) United States silver certificates, United 1-26 1-27 1-28 States Treasury notes, and Federal Reserve System notes;

(C) an official foreign bank note that is customarily used and accepted as a medium of exchange in a foreign 1-29 1-30 country and a foreign bank draft; and
