1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the authority of certain municipalities to propose a  
 1-18 fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services district.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 344.051, Local Government Code, is  
 1-21 amended by adding Subsection (a-3) to read as follows:

1-22 (a-3) The governing body of a municipality may propose the  
 1-23 creation of a fire control, prevention, and emergency medical  
 1-24 services district under this chapter if the municipality:

1-25 (1) has a population of 19,000 or more and less than  
 1-26 60,000; and

1-27 (2) contains a campus of North Central Texas College.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
