A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the allocation of money associated with delays of 1-20 transportation projects. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 222, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 222.007 to read as follows: 1-22 1-23

Sec. 222.007. ALLOCATION OF MONEY FROM TRANSPORTATION 1-24 1-25 PROJECT DELAYS. (a) The department shall establish a system to track liquidated damages, including road user costs, retained by the department associated with delayed transportation project 1-26 1-27 1-28 contracts.

1-29 (b) The system must allow the department to correlate the 1-30 liquidated damages with:

(1) the project that was the subject of the damages; 1-31 1-32 and

1-33 (2) each department district in which the project that 1-34 was the subject of the damages is located. 1-35

(c) Each year, the department shall:

(1) for each department district, determine the amount of money described by Subsection (a) retained in the previous year that is attributable to projects located in the district; and 1-36 1-37 1-38

(2) in addition to other amounts, allocate to 1-39 each department district an amount of money equal to the amount 1-40 determined for the district under Subdivision (1) to be used for transportation projects located in that district. 1-41 1-42

(d) If a transportation project that was 1-43 the subject of 1 - 44liquidated damages is located in more than one department district, 1-45 the department may reasonably allocate the amount of the liquidated damages from that project among the districts in which the project 1-46 1-47 is located. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
