## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-22 relating to civil and administrative penalties assessed or imposed 1-23 for violations of laws protecting drinking water, public water 1-24 supplies, and bodies of water. 1-25

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 341.048(b), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-27 1-28 (b) A person who causes, suffers, allows, or permits a violation under this subchapter shall be assessed a civil penalty 1-29 of not less than \$50 and not [nor] more than \$5,000 [\$1,000] for each violation. Each day of a continuing violation is a separate 1-30 1-31 violation. 1-32

1-33 SECTION 2. Section 341.049(a), Health and Safety Code, is 1-34 amended to read as follows:

1-35 (a) If a person causes, suffers, allows, or permits a violation of this subchapter or a rule or order adopted under this 1-36 subchapter, the commission may assess a penalty against that person as provided by this section. The penalty shall not be less than \$50 and not [nor] more than \$5,000 [\$1,000] for each violation. Each 1-37 1-38 1-39 1-40 day of a continuing violation may be considered a separate violation. 1-41

SECTION 3. (a) Section 341.048(b), Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, applies to an action brought on or after the 1-42 1-43 1-44 effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the violation 1-45 giving rise to that action occurred on, before, or after that date. (b) Section 341.049(a), Health and Safety Code, as amended

1-46 by this Act, applies only to a violation that occurs on or after the 1-47 effective date of this Act. A violation that occurs before the 1-48 1-49 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the 1-50 date the violation was committed, and the former law is continued in 1-51 effect for that purpose.
