- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 545.356(b-1), (c), and (d),
- 6 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) Except as provided by Subsection (b-3), the governing
- 8 body of a municipality, for a highway or a part of a highway in the
- 9 municipality that is not an officially designated or marked highway
- 10 or road of the state highway system, may declare a lower speed limit
- 11 of not less than 20 $[\frac{25}{25}]$ miles per hour, if the governing body
- 12 determines that the prima facie speed limit on the highway is
- 13 unreasonable or unsafe.
- 14 (c) A prima facie speed limit that is altered by the
- 15 governing body of a municipality under Subsection (b) $[\frac{}{}, \frac{}{}, \frac{}{}, \frac{}{}, \frac{}{}]$ or
- 16 (b-3) is effective when the governing body erects signs giving
- 17 notice of the new limit [and at all times or at other times as
- 18 determined]. A prima facie speed limit that is altered by the
- 19 governing body of a municipality under Subsection (b-1) is
- 20 effective when the governing body erects signs or has completed a
- 21 public education campaign giving notice of the new limit that
- 22 includes notification of the effective date of the change.
- 23 (d) The governing body of a municipality that declares a
- 24 lower speed limit on a highway or part of a highway under Subsection

- 1 (b-1) or (b-3), not later than February 1 of each year, shall
- 2 publish on its Internet website and submit to the department a
- 3 report that compares for each of the two previous calendar years:
- 4 (1) the number of traffic citations issued by peace
- 5 officers of the municipality and the alleged speed of the vehicles,
- 6 for speed limit violations on the highway or part of the highway;
- 7 [(2) the number of warning citations issued by peace
- 8 officers of the municipality on the highway or part of the highway;
- 9 and
- 10 $\underline{(2)}$ [$\overline{(3)}$] the number of vehicular accidents that
- 11 resulted in injury or death and were attributable to speed limit
- 12 violations on the highway or part of the highway.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
