 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to allowing safety recall information to be included in a
 1-22 vehicle inspection report.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 382.202, Health and Safety Code, is
 1-25 amended by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

1-26 (d-1) The commission may adopt rules providing for the
 1-27 inclusion on a vehicle inspection report for a vehicle inspected in
 1-28 a county that is included in a vehicle emissions inspection and
 1-29 maintenance program under Subchapter F, Chapter 548,
 1-30 Transportation Code, of notification regarding whether the vehicle
 1-31 is subject to a safety recall for which the vehicle has not been
 1-32 repaired or the repairs are incomplete. The commission may accept
 1-33 gifts, grants, and donations from any source, including private and
 1-34 nonprofit organizations, for the purpose of providing the
 1-35 notification described by this subsection.

1-36 SECTION 2. Section 548.252, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-37 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-38 (c) The department may adopt rules providing for the
 1-39 inclusion on a vehicle inspection report for a vehicle inspected
 1-40 under this chapter notification regarding whether the vehicle is
 1-41 subject to a safety recall for which the vehicle has not been
 1-42 repaired or the repairs are incomplete. The department may accept
 1-43 gifts, grants, and donations from any source, including private and
 1-44 nonprofit organizations, for the purpose of providing the
 1-45 notification described by this subsection.

1-46 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
