## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the construction manager-at-risk method of contracting
- 3 for governmental construction projects.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2269.255(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A construction manager-at-risk shall publicly advertise
- 8 for bids or proposals and receive bids or proposals from trade
- 9 contractors or subcontractors for the performance of all major
- 10 elements of the work other than the minor work that may be included
- 11 in the general conditions. Except as otherwise provided by this
- 12 subchapter, a construction manager-at-risk shall use the
- 13 competitive bidding method or competitive sealed proposal method to
- 14 consider a contract with a trade contractor or subcontractor in the
- 15 manner required by this chapter for a governmental entity to
- 16 consider a contract with a contractor. If a construction
- 17 manager-at-risk uses the competitive sealed proposal method to
- 18 consider a contract with a trade contractor or subcontractor:
- 19 (1) price must be one of the selection criteria; and
- 20 (2) the weighted value of price as a selection
- 21 criterion must be at least half of the total weighted value of all
- 22 of the selection criteria.
- SECTION 2. Section 2269.256(a), Government Code, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:

- 1 (a) The construction manager-at-risk shall review all trade 2 contractor or subcontractor bids or proposals in a manner that does not disclose the contents of the bid or proposal during the selection process to a person not employed by the construction 4 5 manager-at-risk, architect, engineer, or governmental entity. All bids or proposals shall be made available to the governmental 6 entity [on request] and to the public not later than the seventh day 7 8 after the later of the award of the contract or [the seventh day after] the date of final selection of bids or proposals.
- SECTION 3. Sections 2269.255(a) and 2269.256(a),
  Government Code, as amended by this Act, apply only in relation to a
  contract for which a construction manager-at-risk first advertises
  bids or proposals on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
