1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the composition of the board of directors of the Gateway  
 1-18 Groundwater Conservation District.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 8839.051(a), Special District Local Laws  
 1-21 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-22 (a) The district is governed by a board of not more than two  
 1-23 directors for each county in the district [~~in the manner provided by~~  
 1-24 ~~Section 36.051, Water Code~~]. The board may change the total number  
 1-25 of directors on the board if the district annexes territory.

1-26 SECTION 2. (a) The legal notice of the intention to  
 1-27 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this  
 1-28 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a  
 1-29 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,  
 1-30 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished  
 1-31 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,  
 1-32 Government Code.

1-33 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has  
 1-34 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on  
 1-35 Environmental Quality.

1-36 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed  
 1-37 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the  
 1-38 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of  
 1-39 representatives within the required time.

1-40 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this  
 1-41 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect  
 1-42 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled  
 1-43 and accomplished.

1-44 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-45 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-46 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-47 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-48 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
