A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the supervision of water districts by the Texas
- 3 Commission on Environmental Quality.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.081(a), Water Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The powers and duties of all districts and authorities
- 8 created under Article III, Section 52 and Article XVI, Section 59 of
- 9 the Texas Constitution are subject to the continuing right of
- 10 supervision of the State of Texas by and through the commission or
- 11 its successor, and this supervision may include but is not limited
- 12 to the authority to:
- 13 (1) inquire into the qualifications [competence,
- 14 fitness, and reputation] of the officers and directors of any
- 15 district or authority;
- 16 (2) require, on its own motion or on complaint by any
- 17 person, audits or other financial information, inspections,
- 18 evaluations, and engineering reports;
- 19 (3) issue subpoenas for witnesses to carry out its
- 20 authority under this subsection;
- 21 (4) institute investigations and hearings that shall
- 22 be conducted by the State Office of Administrative Hearings [using
- 23 examiners appointed by the commission];
- 24 (5) issue rules necessary to supervise the districts

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- 1 and authorities, except that such rules shall not apply to water
- 2 quality ordinances adopted by any river authority which meet or
- 3 exceed minimum requirements established by the commission; and
- 4 (6) the right of supervision granted herein shall not
- 5 apply to matters relating to electric utility operations.
- 6 SECTION 2. Sections 49.102(e) and (f), Water Code, are
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (e) If a majority of the votes cast in the election favor the
- 9 creation of the district, then the temporary board shall declare
- 10 that the district is created and enter the result in its minutes.
- 11 If a majority of the votes cast in the election are against the
- 12 creation of the district, the temporary board shall declare that
- 13 the district was defeated and enter the result in its minutes. A
- 14 copy of the order shall be filed with the commission not later than
- 15 the 30th day after the date of the election.
- 16 (f) The order canvassing the results of the confirmation
- 17 election shall contain a description of the district's boundaries
- 18 and shall be filed with the executive director and in the deed
- 19 records of the county or counties in which the district is located
- 20 not later than the 30th day after the date of the election.
- SECTION 3. Section 49.195(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (a) The executive director may review the audit report of
- 24 each district. After reviewing the audit report, the executive
- 25 director may request additional information from the district. The
- 26 district shall provide the additional information not later than
- 27 the 60th day after the date the request was received, unless the

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- 1 executive director extends the time allowed for the district to
- 2 provide additional information for good cause.
- 3 SECTION 4. Section 49.196(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 (a) The executive director may review and investigate a
- 6 district's financial records and may conduct an on-site audit of a
- 7 <u>district's financial information.</u> The executive director shall
- 8 have access to all vouchers, receipts, district fiscal and
- 9 financial records, and other district records the executive
- 10 director considers necessary.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
