## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to ballot language requirements for a proposition seeking
- 3 voter approval for the issuance of bonds.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 52.072, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 7 follows:

- 8 (e) In addition to any other requirement imposed by law for
- 9 a proposition, including a provision prescribing the proposition
- 10 language, a proposition submitted to the voters for approval of the
- 11 issuance of bonds or the imposition, increase, or reduction of a tax
- 12 shall specifically state, as applicable:
- 13 (1) with respect to a proposition seeking voter
- 14 approval of the issuance of bonds:
- 15 (A) the total principal amount of the bonds to be
- 16 authorized, if approved; [and]
- 17 (B) a [general] description of the single
- 18 specific purpose [the purposes] for which the bonds are to be
- 19 authorized, if approved; and
- (C) the rate of any tax that will be increased or
- 21 imposed to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds;
- 22 (2) with respect to a proposition that only seeks
- 23 voter approval of the imposition or increase of a tax, the amount of
- 24 or maximum tax rate of the tax or tax increase for which approval is

- 1 sought; or
- 2 (3) with respect to a proposition that only seeks
- 3 voter approval of the reduction of a tax, the amount of tax rate
- 4 reduction or the tax rate for which approval is sought.
- 5 (f) Each single specific purpose for which bonds requiring
- 6 voter approval are to be issued must be printed on the ballot as a
- 7 <u>separate proposition</u>.
- 8 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 10 An election ordered before the effective date of this Act is
- 11 governed by the law in effect when the election was ordered, and the
- 12 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
