1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to standards for nutrition, physical activity, and screen
 1-22 time for certain child-care facilities and homes.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 42.042, Human Resources Code, is amended
 1-25 by adding Subsections (e-3) and (e-4) to read as follows:

1-26 (e-3) The minimum standards for a day-care center or a
 1-27 registered family home adopted under Subsection (e) must be
 1-28 consistent with:

1-29 (1) the most recent edition of the standards for
 1-30 physical activity and screen time as published by the American
 1-31 Academy of Pediatrics in Caring for Our Children: National Health
 1-32 and Safety Performance Standards; Guidelines for Early Care and
 1-33 Education Programs; and

1-34 (2) the nutrition standards in the Child and Adult
 1-35 Care Food Program administered by the Department of Agriculture.

1-36 (e-4) A day-care center or registered family home is not
 1-37 required to participate in or comply with the reporting
 1-38 requirements of the Child and Adult Care Food Program administered
 1-39 by the Department of Agriculture.

1-40 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
 1-41 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
 1-42 Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to implement
 1-43 the changes in law made by this Act.

1-44 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
