1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to conditions of community supervision applicable to
 1-20 certain intoxication offenses.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Article 42A.402, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
 1-23 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-24 (e) If, based on the evaluation conducted under Subsection
 1-25 (d), the judge determines that the defendant would likely benefit
 1-26 from medication-assisted treatment approved by the United States
 1-27 Food and Drug Administration for alcohol dependence, the judge may
 1-28 require as a condition of community supervision that the defendant
 1-29 submit to an evaluation by a licensed physician to determine
 1-30 whether the defendant would benefit from medication-assisted
 1-31 treatment. Only a licensed physician may recommend that a
 1-32 defendant participate in medication-assisted treatment. A
 1-33 defendant is entitled to refuse to participate in
 1-34 medication-assisted treatment, and a judge may not require as a
 1-35 condition of community supervision that the defendant participate
 1-36 in medication-assisted treatment.

1-37 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
 1-38 defendant placed on community supervision on or after the effective
 1-39 date of this Act, regardless of whether the offense for which the
 1-40 defendant was placed on community supervision was committed before,
 1-41 on, or after the effective date of this Act.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
