## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to eligible participants in the Texas Achieving a Better Life Experience (ABLE) Program. 1-21 1-22 1-23

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 54.910(b), Education Code, is amended to 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 1-27 (b) If the designated beneficiary of the account is not able to exercise signature authority over the account, or if a designated beneficiary chooses to establish an account but not 1-28 exercise signature authority [a minor or has a custodian or other fiduciary appointed for the purpose of managing the minor's financial affairs], the parent, legal guardian, [or custodian] or other fiduciary of the beneficiary may serve as the participant if 1-29 1-30 1-31 1-32 1-33 [that form of ownership is] permitted [or not prohibited] by 1-34 Section 529A, Internal Revenue Code.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-36 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 1-39

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
